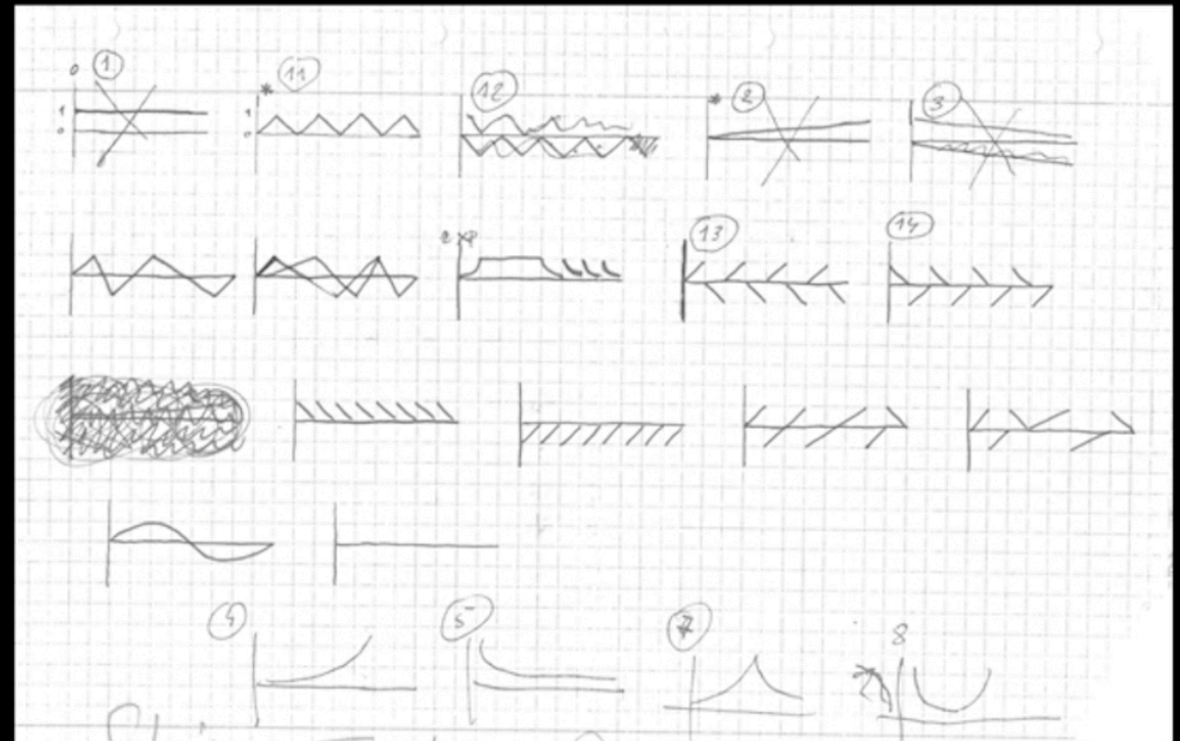

is composed with Csound, that time our only environment for digital sound synthesis and main learning and composing tool at the Electronic Studio of the Musikohschule Lübeck back in the 90ies.

„Fonction d'onde formantique“ is a synthesis method, initially developed in IRCAM under the name „Chant“, to emulate human singing voice.

In this little etude, the 15 parameters of Csound's FOF-opcode have been manipulated, individually or group-wise, moving between subaudio and audio values and resulting a grotesque landscape of daemonic fluttering in a 4-channel space.



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
